Zambia Term 2 Team to Lusaka, Zambia August 8-18, 2019 Trip Code #19009

This fact sheet will give you some general information. Once we have received your application and \$500 down payment, you will receive a letter of introduction to the team that will contain more details and a trip itinerary. The scope of this trip is VBS Adventure Camp.

❖ **Important Dates:** The dates of the trip are Thursday, August 8, through Sunday, August 18, 2019. The deadline for applications is April 1, 2019. The application process, which includes application, medical release, and GO Team Agreement, must be completed online by this date. The application must be accompanied by online down payment of \$500.

Because we realize the importance of being able to process the events of your trip after you return home, a date for a debriefing meeting has been scheduled for Saturday, September 21, 2019. Your team leader will confirm this date or communicate an alternate date with your team.

❖ **Preparation:** In order to be adequately prepared, we ask all team members to participate in a series of mandatory Team Building sessions. These sessions prepare team members for all the dynamics of traveling cross-culturally with 10 - 15 people and give opportunities to prepare for the ministry portion of the trip. These mandatory sessions are **May 31 and June 1**. There will also be a meeting for packing **TBD**.

❖ **Application:** Each team member must submit an online GO Team application with a \$500 online down payment. The Medical Release form and the Team Agreement form must also be completed in order to be considered for the team. The trip application also asks for approval from parents for minors to participate on a team. All paper work must be filled out online at www.horizonorphans.com/goteams.

❖ **Documents:** You must have a valid passport that does not expire with six months of the date of departure and has at least two clean pages for the visa. A copy of your passport must accompany your application.

❖ **Payment:** All payments for this trip should be made through the Horizon International. The cost of this trip is estimated at \$3,100, all of which is due before the team departs. The \$500 deposit is due on April 1, and payments of \$800 are due on May 15, \$900 due on June 15, and \$900 due on July 8. (Please note that the cost could fluctuate slightly depending on currency exchange rates and final flight costs.) When adding funds to your trip, please use the **Trip Code #19009** and include your name in the memo line. To make an online payment, go to <https://horizonorphans.com/donate/>, click on "Give to a GO Team Member", enter amount then click on "Give" and then "Proceed to Checkout". **VERY IMPORTANT:** Add **GO Team member's name** and the **trip number (19009)** to the **Order Notes** before submitting payment.

We offer information and materials available to assist you in building a support network. This information can be found on the *Faith and Finances* tab. Any fundraising materials sent out must include the following statement, "This contribution is made with the understanding that Horizon has complete control over the use of these donated funds in compliance with Internal Revenue Service requirements."

❖ **Lodging and Hosts:** We stay at very comfortable Guest Houses, which are secure environments close to our ministry sites. Meals are included with lodging and bottled water is always available. Our hosts are a Zambian couple, Moses and Cecilia, who serve as the Horizon International coordinators for Zambia.

❖ **Daily Routine:** Each day starts with a wonderful breakfast followed by worship and devotions. We travel to a nearby village for the camp ministry with children. One day a week is devoted to visiting attractions in the country.

❖ **Medical:** Our best advice is for you to contact your medical professional and talk with them about the vaccinations required for this trip. Oftentimes, vaccinations must be given early enough that our bodies have time to develop protection, or vaccinations may require more than one dose, therefore we strongly recommend seeing your physician as soon as possible.

❖ **Insurance:** Your own health insurance will serve as the primary coverage, but we do provide secondary traveler's Insurance, which covers many of the international emergencies that normal health insurance typically may not. We suggest contacting your insurance company prior to your trip.

❖ **Weather:** This time of year the temperatures in Zambia are generally in the mid-70s during the day and may drop to the 60's at night.
