Your sponsored child has two siblings that are not sponsored. You're not able to sponsor them, so you share the need with your family and friends.



Your sister sponsors your child's brother.

Later, she shares about other orphans in his village that are in need of sponsors. I

As a result, her friend and a coworker also become sponsors.

Shortly after I signed up to go on my very first GO team, Andrew and I began sponsoring a young man named Samson. In the years that followed, I would frequently travel to Zambia and visit Samson in his home.

On one visit, I learned that Samson had a brother named Richard. He was sitting off on his own, away from the group. His eyes were downcast and he was totally disengaged. He looked hopeless, ashamed, and left out. I asked a Horizon Zambia staff member what was going on with Richard. She told me that

I went home and immediately began to advocate for Richard. I shared about him with all of my friends and family, anyone who would listen. That's when my cousin, Amanda Craig, stepped up and committed to sponsor Richard for as long as it would take for him to finish school.

Since that day, I have been privileged to return to Zambia many more times and visit with Richard. The change in him due to sponsorship is nothing short of miraculous. His eyes went from dead and hopeless, to alive and filled with hope and possibility. Richard now smiles and laughs. He attends school. He dances and sings. He is a confident young man with a bright future.

It gives me great joy that the Lord allowed me to be a part of connecting Richard and Amanda's lives. I have no doubt that the ripple effect of this union will be felt for generations to come and is having an eternal impact.
